Chad Brauer, Osage Beach, Missouri

Chad has been fishing professionally for eight years. His career highlights include being a 1998 BASS[†] Masters Classic Qualifier, placing 1st in 1996 BASS Tennessee Top 100. Chad is married with two children, and is the son of Team Evinrude's Denny Brauer.

Denny Brauer, Camdenton, Missouri

Denny Brauer is a fishing legend and proud member of Team Evinrude. He has been fishing professionally for 23 years, and this year has qualified to fish the Elite 50 on the BASS tour. Denny's career highlights include: BASS All-Time Money Winner, Single Season Record Holder, Classic Champion, BASS & FLW Angler of the Year, 12 BASS victories and a recent induction into the Bass Fishing Hall of Fame. Denny's family consists of his wife, Shirley, son, Chad, daughter-in-law, Nikki, and two grandchildren, Colby and Abby.

Patrick Campeau, Laval, Québec, Canada

Patrick Campeau, a three-time BASS Québec Champion, has been fishing professionally for 14 years. He collaborates with 85 radio stations and is recognized as a spokesperson on the fishing scene in Québec. Patrick's first Evinrude engine was a 1957 Evinrude Fleetwin 7.5-hp.

Steve Daniel, Clewiston, Florida

Steve Daniel has been fishing professionally for 20 years. His career highlights include a First FLW Championship Winner, two FLW tournament tour wins, and three-time BASS Masters Classic Qualifier. Steve's biggest fan is his wife, Debbie, who travels with him to cheer his victories at every tournament.

Gary Dobyms, Yuba City, California

Northern California grown, but self-described “Okie” (his family roots are in Oklahoma), Gary grew up fishing the numerous ponds and sloughs throughout the Yuba. Since fishing professionally, Gary has won just about every title there is to win and has expanded his scope by venturing beyond the West, participating in national events, and representing industry sponsors at sportsman shows and promotions throughout the country. Gary’s accolades include: 13-time Angler of the Year, three-time West Coast Bass Classic Champion, W.O.N. Western Classic Champion, Western Bass Classic Champion and the 2002 Western Outdoor News Ranger Cup Champion. With more than 50 Western tournament wins, Gary is the all-time leading money winner in the Western United States.

Scott Fairbairn, Hager City, Wisconsin

A professional Walleye angler since 1994, Scott has competed in the Professional Walleye Trail and Cabela’s NAWA Circuit. In 2003, he tied for fifth with fellow Team Evinrude angler Eric Olson in the final standings for the RCL Walleye Tour standings. In 1998, Scott was the Professional Walleye Trail Angler of the Year and the PWT Western Pro Am Champion. In 2000, Scott won the PWT Central Pro Am Championship. Scott is a 10-time national walleye championship qualifier and has 15 top-10 finishes to his credit.

Chris Gilman, Chicago City, Minnesota

Chris Gilman would like to be remembered for “contributing a great deal to the sport of walleye angling.” He has been fishing professionally for 13 years and has many career highlights including Professional Walleye Trail Angler of the Year, two-time PWT Top Gun, and three times PWT Champion and Mercury National Champion. Aside from fishing, Chris’ activities include spending time with his family consisting of his wife, Kathi, and three children, Nathan, Easton and Brenna.

Pete Gluszek, Franklinville, New Jersey

Pete competes in the BASS tournament trail. He has been fishing professionally since 1996, with his first win at the Alabama Invitational in 1999. Pete has eight top-10 finishes and has competed in two BASSMASTER Classics. For the season, Pete will run the highly visible Ranger NASCAR boat powered by Evinrude.

Dion Hibdon, Stover, Missouri

Dion Hibdon has been fishing professionally for 19 years. His highlights include 1997 BASS Masters Classic Champion and 2000 FLW Championship Winner. He has 19 top-10 finishes on tour and was ranked 32 in 2003. Dion's favorite method of fishing is jig fishing. When he is not fishing, he prides himself as being the entertainment director for his wife, Jill, and three children, Payden, Lawson and Connor. Dion is also the son of Guido Hibdon.

Guido Hibdon, Gravois Mills, Missouri

The legendary Guido Hibdon has been fishing professionally for more than 34 years. He is a member of the Professional Bass Fishing Hall of Fame and has four top-10 finishes on the FLW tours. Guido has been a two-time BASS Angler of the Year and 1988 BASS Masters Classic Winner. Guido's biggest fans consist of his family: wife, Stella, children, Chuck, Dottie and Dion, and three grandchildren. Guido and Dion are also the only father/son Classic winners.

Davy Hite, Prosperity, South Carolina

Team Evinrude's own 2002 BASS "Angler of the Year," Hite won the 1999 BASSMASTERS Classic and finished 9th in 2002. He was also the BASS "Angler of the Year" in 1997, is qualified to fish the Elite 50 on the BASS tour in 2004, and has five career wins under his belt.

Dan Morehead, Paducah, Kentucky

In 2003, Dan captured the Forest L. Woods (FLW) Angler of the Year title, culminating his nine years of professional fishing. Dan has competed in three BASSMASTERS Classics and seven FLW Championships. He won the 1998 Missouri Invitational, 1st place Top 100 in Maryland, 1st place Kentucky Lake Everstart in 2002 and 1st place Kentucky Lake FLW in 1998. Dan is married and has a young daughter, Sarah.

Larry Nixon, Bee Branch, Arkansas

Larry is a two-time BASS "Angler of the Year". During his 27 years of professional fishing, he has captured 14 BASS titles including BASS "Angler of the Year" in 1980 and 1982, a 1983 Classic Win, a winner of two FLW events, and fished 23 BASSMASTER Classics. In 2003, he ranked eighth in standings for the FLW. He has been inducted into the Freshwater Fishing Hall of Fame, the Arkansas Outdoor Hall of Fame and the Professional Bass Fishing Hall of Fame. Larry is married with three children and enjoys hunting in his free time.

Eric Olson, Minneapolis, Minnesota

Eric Olson is a huge supporter and educator of the sport of fishing. He has been fishing professionally for nine years, and in 2003, he tied for fifth with fellow Team Evinrude angler Scott Fairbairn in the final standings for the RCL Walleye Tour standings. Eric's career highlights include winning the 2000 Wal-Mart World Walleye Championship and being a six-time Walleye Championship qualifier. He holds three top-ten finishes and five top-20 finishes. Eric's biggest fan is his wife, Melissa.

Rick Olson, Mina Lake, South Dakota

A Professional Walleye angler since 1992, Rick is one of the most decorated Walleye anglers competing today. He holds the title of 2001 Wal-Mart RCL Angler-of-the-Year. Rick was also the 1992 PWT Rookie of the year and 2000 PWT Angler of the Year. Rick has 29 top-10 finishes and 45 top-20 finishes, PWT and RCL tournament circuits.

Tommy Skarlis, Walker, Minnesota

Tommy is the All-Time PWT Total Tournament Weight Record-Holder. In 2003, he ranked second in the final standings for the RCL Walleye Tour standings. He also holds two PWT titles, two MWC titles, and has qualified for 16 National Championships. Tommy has been fishing professionally for 11 years. He says if he was not a professional angler, he would be a homebuilder.

Emily Shaffer, Mt. Juliet, Tennessee

Emily has been a professional bass angler for 12 years. Emily competes in the Forest L. Wood tour, and in 2002 was the Women's Bass Fishing league "Angler of the Year." Emily also holds the 1995 Bass n'Gal Classic Championship, two national titles and is a 10-time Classic qualifier.

Carl Svebek, Sialom Springs, Arkansas

Carl has been fishing professionally for six years. His career highlights include a 1st place finish in Everstart at Lake Sam Rayburn, 1st place TTT Tournament Trail at Lake Sam Rayburn, four top-10s in the FLW, two top-five's in the FLW and 5th place in ESPN's Great Outdoor Games 2000. Carl's biggest fans are his wife, Kelly, and two daughters, Carlie and McKenzie.

David Walker, Sevierville, Tennessee

David finished third in both the 2002 and 2001 BASSMASTERS Classics and was the 1999 FLW Angler of the Year. David is a five-time FLW Championship Qualifier, three-time BASSMASTER Classic Qualifier and a Redman All-American Qualifier. David enjoys saltwater fishing with his wife, Misty, when they get the chance.

Mike Wurm, Hot Springs, Arkansas

Mike is a tour veteran who began fishing the BASSMASTER circuit in 1992 and the FLW circuit in 1998. Mike has nine top ten BASS finishes and six top-10 FLW finishes. He won the Georgia Top 100 in 1997 and the 1999 FLW Lake Murray, and has appeared in six BASSMASTERS Classics and five FLW Championships. In 2003, Mike ranked seventh in the BASS Angler of the Year standings. Mike is an avid golfer when he is not fishing.
